



## The Project MOBIS

The University of Foggia (Italy) is pleased to announce a call for international students to participate in national project called “MOBIS”.

The Georgian Technical University (GTU) is organizing a call to select student taking part in the mobility project coordinated by the University of Foggia (Università degli studi di Foggia). Thanks to the collaboration agreed by the universities, 1 student from GTU will be able to do an exchange during the 2017-2018 academic year at the University of Foggia.

The Italian project provides opportunities for Georgian students to spend study periods at the University of Foggia and supports students in acquiring the skills (knowledge, qualities and attitudes) in order to enhance their personal development and their employability.

Applicants must be registered at GTU as full-degree students at the time of application. They must also be able to continue studies at the same level (undergraduate, masters, PhD) at GTU the following year, i.e. the year of the exchange.

Required documentation for the Georgian Technical University students:

- Copy of valid passport
- EUROPASS CV
- Motivation Letter
- Certificate of Language proficiency (if applicant studies at English language program, Certificate of Language proficiency is not mandatory)
- Transcript of records
- Reference letter
- Explanatory statement of applicant’s disability, economical or social needs (if applicable)
- Recently obtained Diploma and Diploma supplement (if applicable)
- Research plan (only for PhD applicants)
- Acceptance letter by the counterpart at host university accepting the proposed work plan included in the provisional mobility agreement (e-mail letter is acceptable) (only for PhD applicants)
