GTU is organizing a call to select undergraduate students and academic/administrative staff taking part in the Erasmus+ KA107 mobility project coordinated by the <u>Catholic University of Saint Anthony (Catholic University of Murcia) – UCAM (Murcia, Spain)</u>.

Thanks to the collaboration agreed by the universities, up to 2 BA students and up to 6 academic and 3 administrative staff from Georgian Technical University will be able to do an exchange during the $2^{\rm nd}$ semester of the 2017-2018 academic year at the Catholic University of Saint Anthony (Catholic University of Murcia) – UCAM (Murcia, Spain).

The selected students will benefit from the following grant: 800 euro per month for up to five months and travels costs.

The selected administrative staff will benefit from the following grant: 120 euro per day up to 5 days and travel costs.

As the language of instruction at UCAM is Spanish, International Students are strongly recommended to attend UCAM "Lengua Española y Cultura Hispánica" with 5 ECTS.

- For Academic/Administrative Staff: any time after the official selection date and within UCAM semesters classes dates, to be agreed with the receiving faculties (priority to Business Administration, Management, Modern Languages, International Relations fields due to the project's assumptions).
