Georgian National Academy of Sciences, Georgian Technical University (GTU) and Georgian Association of Science History, with financial support of the Shota Rustaveli National Science Foundation invite you to participate in the International Conference on “Physical Methods of Investigation in Medicine” that will be held at the Georgian Technical University (Tbilisi, Georgia) during 27-29 October 2011.

Reports about physical methods (x-ray, laser, NMR, ultrasonic, etc.) and their use in diagnostics and treatment in various areas of medicine will be presented at the Conference.

The Conference purpose is to promote partner cooperation of the scientists working in the field of physical methods of investigations, with experts of public health services and to exchange of their experience and practical skills for the further development of these methods and their wider application.

The special attention will be turned to joint reports of physicists and experts of medicine on the possibilities of nanotechnologies in medicine.

Acceptance of recommendations about the further scientific cooperation is provided (about the organization of periodic conferences, schools or other actions for the given subjects).

The authors wishing to take part in the Conference should send electronically till **August, 10**, 2011 theses in total amount no more than 1 page (A4), issued in a MS Word Format with a font Times New Roman to the Conference Secretariat by e-mail: phys.med@gtu.ge.

Till September, 1, 2011 authors of the reports selected for conference will receive corresponding notices and invitations for participation in the Conference.

Organizers plan to print reports of conference to its beginning. Therefore we convincingly ask you to send electronic versions of reports till **September, 30th**. The report volume shouldn't exceed 7 pages issued in a **PDF format**, the size A4 (margins – 2 cm) including summary, key words, drawings, schedules, tables and the literature.

Correspondence participation in conference is supposed. In this case theses and reports of authors will be published in the collection of works of Conference if they are presented in due time.

Participants of the Conference will not pay Conference fees.

Working languages of the Conference are Georgian, English and Russian.

During the Conference the cultural actions are planned.
