Requirements for preparing the articles:

- The article should be presented in the format A4 and Word text editor. All margins: 2,5 cm;
- The name of the article file should be name of the first author and number of the working theme (e. g. Manjgaladze-2);
- The used font: for the articles in Georgian - **Sylfaen**. For the articles in Poland, English and Russian - **Times New Roman**. Space between lines - 1.0;
- The formulae should be printed in the Microsoft Equation Editor;
- The graphical material should be compatible with the Word program;
- The title of the article should be printed in the first line (13 Pt, Bold);
- The author(s)'s name(s) and initials - with the one-line space;
- The sort summary (11 Pt, italic, no more than 600 characters) with the one-line space;
- Key words - with the one-line space;
- The basic text - with the one-line space;
- The references (11 Pt) - with the two-line space;
- The volume of the article - 3 to 6 pages.

The registration card and electronic version of the short summary should be sent beforehand by e-mail. After heaving sent the paper, the author will be informed about accepting it. Then, the author should send a copy of the organizational fee ticket (in the pdf format). The both files (paper and ticket copy) should be named by the name of the first author and number of the working theme (ex. Manjgaladze-2). The papers not meeting the above mentioned requirements will not be considered.
