Lecture Course on Signal Processing, at WPUT

On June 6–10, 2022 Assoc. Prof. Nikoloz Abzianidze from GTU Faculty of Informatics and Control Systems visited West Pomeranian University of Technology –WPUT, Szczecin (Poland), within Erasmus+ mobility project for teaching activities. The activity was held within the framework of the Erasmus+ mobility project coordinated by the Polish University.



Teaching activities consisted of 8-hour course in “Signal Processing”. The course was delivered for Erasmus Students studying at the Faculty of Electrical Engineering.

GTU’s Professor was hosted by the Erasmus+ International Coordinator Ms. Agata Bruska; Prof. Joanna Górecka from the Electrical Engineering Faculty and academic staff of the faculty.

Were discussed the issues related to joint research projects between Universities. Assoc. Prof. Nikoloz Abzianidze delivered the presentation introducing ongoing educational and scientific activities and the issues of appropriate innovative teaching methods in GTU as well.

The mobility schedule also included meeting with Assoc. Prof. Marcin Pietrzykowski, Erasmus+ Faculty Coordinator, Department of Artificial Intelligence and Applied Mathematics (Faculty of Computer Science and Information Technology). Were discussed the issues related to working on double degree program in Computer Engineering, Computer Science and Telecommunications.

At the meeting were discussed the perspectives for cooperation between the universities under Erasmus+ Key Action 2 Capacity building in the field of higher education.

The mobility program covered social and cultural activities including sightseeing tours kindly organized by the host faculty members.
