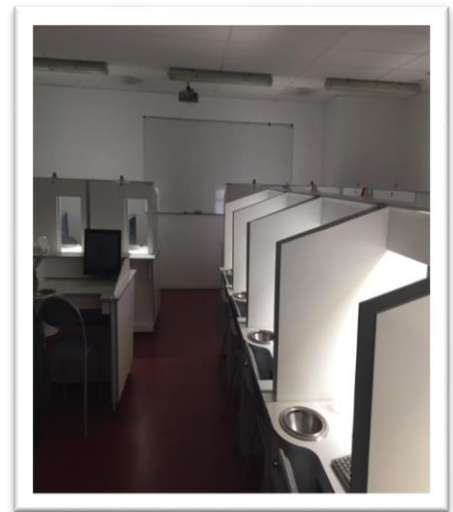
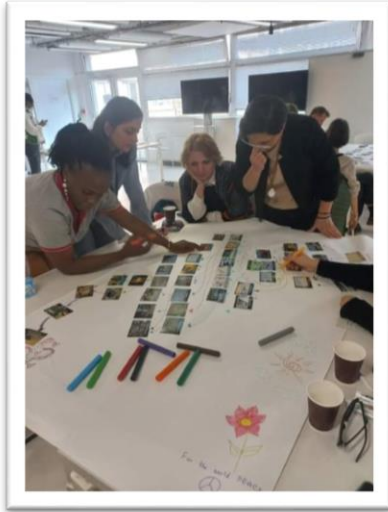


Erasmus+
