In order to verify the level of language proficiency, the applicant must submit International certificate TORFL (The Test of Russian as a Foreign Language) level II certificate (corresponding to testing ALTE level B2 of the European system), as a proof of knowledge of the language of instruction. Such an applicant is exempt from the language test. In the case of absence of similar certificate or other relevant document, the applicant is obliged to pass the test of the language, to demonstrate a real competence, on which teaching is carried out on the educational program chosen by him/her.</p>

In the absence of a similar certificate or other similar document, the applicant will undergo an interview in a foreign language (English, German, French or Russian) with a temporary commission created at the faculty. An applicant who has completed an undergraduate educational program in a foreign language is not required to present a certificate or attend an interview. Enrollment in the program without passing the master's exams is possible according to the rules established by the Ministry of Education and Science of Georgia.</p>
