

Erasmus + mobility for teaching/training in
Silesian Technological University

Silesian University of Technology (SUT) is partner university of GTU. Since I was able to visit SUT last year with Erasmus + mobility program, I was wandering to visit this university again to have some more collaboration opportunities with SUT biomedical engineering faculty. So, I decided to make another Erasmus + mobility in this university.

Mobility period was 12-16 June, at that time I took party in International Staff Training Week organized by SUT.
