From July 2 to 7, 2023, I was at the University of Paris-Dacclès in France with the Erasmus Plus exchange program.

We were 4 administrative staff from the Technical University, from the Faculty of Informatics and Management Systems and Medicine.

I am happy that I got into this university because, it is one of the leading universities in Europe and is in a leading position in Europe in various fields (mathematics, physics, chemistry).

On July 3, we had our first visit to the university. In particular, we met with the heads of the Department of International Relations. Ivane Javakhishvili State University professors and teachers also attended this meeting.

At the meeting, Lazare Bolton made a presentation about Paris Saclay University and informed us about the details of our visit.

On July 4, we had a visit to the Faculty of Pharmacy of the University. The building of the Faculty of Pharmacy is newly built and equipped with the latest laboratories, where world-renowned scientists work. We met with the Dean of the Faculty of Pharmacy. He spoke about the history and modern achievements of the faculty.

Particular attention was paid to their connection with the pharmaceutical and perfumery industries. It is worth noting that the world-famous pharmaceutical and perfumery companies try to have their offices as close as possible to the university to be the first users of their scientific achievements.

Dean gave a comprehensive answer to our questions.

Then we met the scientists and the heads of the laboratory. I was indelibly impressed by the research going on there, the results of which the world is waiting for. We visited the heart physiology laboratory, where they are currently studying the cardiotoxicity of chemotherapy drugs.

We also visited the latest cancer research laboratories. Also laboratories of depression and other neuropathologies.

Then we visited the pharmacy museum, which is located in the same building.

At the end of the day, we met with a successful Georgian student, Khatia Merabishvili, who became a Master of Science at Paris Saclay University and is currently pursuing her doctoral studies.

On July 5, we had a meeting with the administration of the Faculty of Medicine. The Faculty of Medicine is geographically located in another part of Paris, where many clinics are also located.

We met the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine and other employees of the Dean's Office.

They talked about the faculty, on modern approaches to learning and exams. Answer our questions.

We visited the simulation laboratory, where students study medical manipulations with modern simulators.

My visit to Paris Saclay University was very fruitful. I think that we will be able to introduce certain innovations at the faculty, taking into account the experience of our French colleagues. Currently, our department is reviewing their examination system and we are thinking of implementing it in the future.

I also correspond with Eric Erol, professor of the Faculty of Pharmacy, who works on the subject of cardiomyopathies. I think the experience gained and contacts established will have a significant impact on the development of our department and faculty.
