

**Documents to be submitted to enroll under the mobility rule:**

1. Copy of ID card;
2. Copy of military conscription certificate (for males).
3. Educational card (mark sheet) certified with a seal;
4. Certified copies of all orders in the personal file (initial enrollment; suspension / restoration / termination of status);
5. Document recognizing education received in a foreign country (if any);
6. Bachelor's degree - copy of secondary education certificate;

**Master's degree student** - a copy of a bachelor's degree or equivalent document (see note);

**Doctoral degree student** - a copy of a master's degree or equivalent document (see note).

1. Applicants for mobility to the Bachelor's degree programs of the Faculty of Architecture, Urbanism, and Design (Bachelor's degree program "Architecture"; Russian-language Bachelor's degree program "Architecture"; Bachelor's degree program "Fashion Design Technologies"); **must undergo an interview, which will be held on February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2025 at 11:00 (Address: Tbilisi; Kostava N68, GTU Building I, 4th floor, room 402A)**

2. Applicants for mobility to the Bachelor's degree programs of the International School of Design (English-language Bachelor's degree program "Design"; English-language Bachelor's degree program "Architecture") **must undergo an interview, which will be held from February 4 to 6, 2024 at 12:00 (Address: Tbilisi; 75 Kostava Street, GTU Building VIII; 2nd floor; Auditorium 14)**

Note: The documents submitted by applicants for mobility to the Master's and Doctoral programs listed below will be accepted to the relevant programs considering the prerequisites for admission.

### Prerequisites for admission to Master's Programs

N	Master's degree program	Documentation to be submitted
1	<b>Oil and Gas Technologies (Russian-language)</b>	A person who holds a bachelor's degree or equivalent academic degree in engineering, production and construction, as well as in natural sciences, mathematics and statistics (geology, geophysics, chemistry) is eligible to study in a master's degree program.
2	<b>Forestry</b>	A person with at least a Bachelor's degree in Agricultural Sciences, Science/Natural Sciences, or an equivalent academic degree is eligible to study at a Master's degree program.
3	<b>Livestock farming</b>	A person who holds a bachelor's degree or an equivalent academic degree is eligible to study in a master's degree program (according to the detailed field of the study classifier: "Fisheries"; "Veterinary Science"; "Veterinary Science – Unclassified"; "Plant and Animal Husbandry"; "Biology", it is mandatory to present a certificate/document confirming proficiency in English at level B2.

### Prerequisites for admission to doctoral programs

N	Doctoral Educational Program	Documentation to be submitted
1	<b>Construction</b>	A person who holds a master's degree or equivalent academic degree from the detailed field of the classifier of fields of study: Construction and Civil Engineering is eligible to study.
2	<b>Military Engineering</b>	A person who holds a master's degree or equivalent academic degree from the detailed field of the classification of fields of study Emergency Management, is eligible to study.
3	<b>Water Resources Engineering</b>	A person who holds a master's degree or an equivalent academic degree from the detailed field of the classifier of fields of study is eligible to study: Environmental Science; Ecology
4	<b>Transport</b>	A person who holds a master's degree or equivalent academic degree from the broad field of the classification of fields of study: engineering, manufacturing, and construction is eligible to study.
5	<b>Mechanical Engineering and Technology</b>	A person who holds a master's degree or equivalent academic degree from the broad field of the classification of fields of study: engineering, manufacturing, and construction is eligible to study.
6	<b>International Relations</b>	A person who holds a master's degree or equivalent academic degree from the detailed fields of the classification of fields of study: social sciences, humanities, law, public administration, security and defense is eligible to study.

7	<b>Informatics</b>	A person who holds a master's degree or equivalent academic degree in the following fields of study: "Informatics", "Engineering", "Exact and Natural Sciences", "Economics", is eligible to study.
	<b>Mathematics</b>	A person who holds a master's degree or equivalent academic degree from a narrow field of the classification of fields of study: mathematics and statistics is eligible to study.
8	<b>Control Systems, Automation and Test Engineering</b>	A person who holds a master's degree or an equivalent academic degree from the narrow field of the classification of fields of study, "Engineering and Engineering business", from the detailed fields: "Electronics and Automation", "Electricity and Energy", "Motor Vehicles, Ships and Aircraft", "Engineering and Engineering business – Unclassified"; from the narrow fields: "Information and Communication Technologies", "Mathematics and Statistics" is eligible to study.
9	<b>Biomedical Engineering (English-Language)</b>	A person who holds a master's degree or equivalent academic degree from a narrow field of the classification of fields of study: "Engineering and Engineering business", "Healthcare", "Biological and Related Sciences", "Information and Communication Technologies" is eligible to study.
10	<b>Economy</b>	A person with a relevant education, a master's degree or an equivalent academic degree is entitled to study in the detailed fields of the classification of fields of study – "Economics"; "Educational Sciences"; "Political Sciences and Foundations of Citizenship"; "Social and Behavioral Sciences"; "Accounting and Taxation"; "Finance, Banking and Insurance"; "Management and Administration"; "Marketing and Advertising"; "Law"; "Statistics"; "Tourism"; "Mathematics"; "Informatics"; "Philosophy"; "Healthcare and Social Welfare"; "Engineering and Engineering business".
11	<b>Social Sciences</b>	A person who holds a Master's degree or an equivalent academic degree (broad field of the classifier of fields of study: 01 Education; 02 Arts; Humanities; 03 Social Sciences; Journalism and Information; 04 Business, Administration and Law) is eligible to study;
12	<b>Theology - History of the Georgian Church</b>	A person who holds a Master's degree or an equivalent academic degree (Broad Field of Study Classification: 01 Education; 02 Arts, Humanities; 03 Social Sciences, Journalism and Information; 04 Business, Administration and Law) is eligible to study in a doctoral program.
