

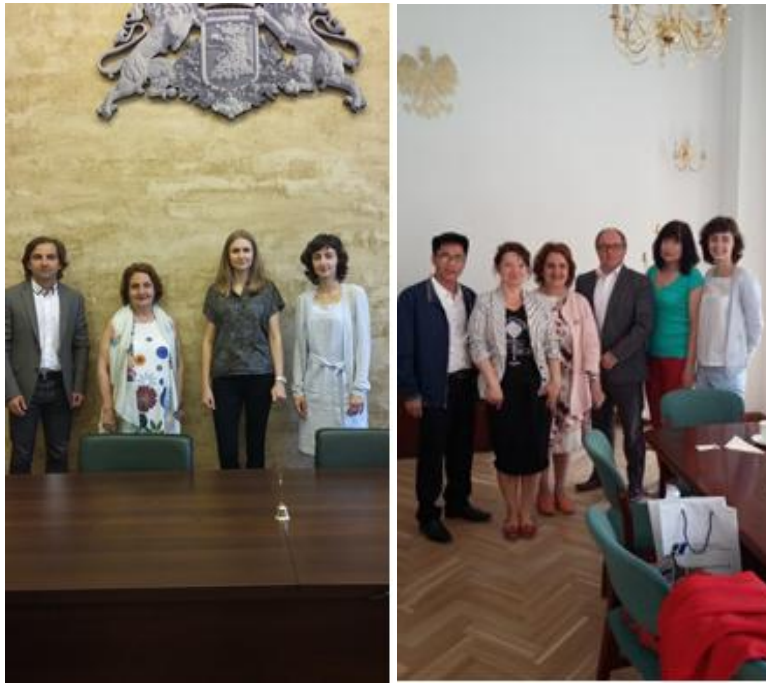
## Erasmus+ Mobility for Training Activities at WPUT – Workshops on ECTS Recognition Procedures
