Duration of the program is 18-months.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- ✓ An undergraduate degree in business, economics, finance, statistics or other related fields is desirable, however, students with degrees in other disciplines are also eligible to apply.
- ✓ English language proficiency

APPLICATION PACKAGE

As an international student, your application for admission to Master of Agribusiness Program must meet the same academic standards for admission as those required of native students.

A complete application package should include:

- ✓ A completed application form ([download here](#))
- ✓ Scanned versions of diplomas and transcripts from all universities attended
- ✓ Scanned versions of passport or National ID
- ✓ Resume/CV
- ✓ Four 3x4 photos
- ✓ Two letters of academic recommendation
- ✓ Certificates, awards, other proves of achievements, if available
- ✓ List of publications, if available
- ✓ Other documents may be requested

Applicants interested in the program should submit their complete application package to admissionsMAB@gmail.com by June 30, 2020.

The applicants will be screened based on their academic background and competencies, then invited for an interview. Shortlisted applicants will be offered one-month preparatory course. Final selection of students will be done based on academic progress during the summer course.

All international applicants should apply in accordance with the provisions of the «Order on admission to higher education institutions of the RA of foreign citizens» issued by RA Government Decision №700-Ն (dated 28 April 2011) Ministry of Education, Science, Culture and Sport.

IMPORTANT: The admission interviews and the preparatory one-month course will be held online. To participate in the core program, students should physically be present and attend classes at ICARE, unless the COVID-19 emergency situation prevails in the country, hence we may be forced to conduct classes online.

TUITION FEE

The tuition fee for the entire program is 1,650,000 AMD (≈ 3430 USD).
