Assist. Prof. Tsutskiridze held a public presentation organized by Prof. Liliana Domingues Reis Ferreira. Young Georgian researcher briefly presented the history of the Georgian Technical University, existed faculties, especially the achievements of the Faculty of Engineering Economics, Media Technologies and Social Sciences, focusing on educational programs at all three levels, university academic and research achievements, international partners, students' life at the Faculty.

When meeting with the first year students of International Relations, besides the presentation of the Georgian Technical University, she spoke about the history and culture of Georgia and on the existing education system of Georgia in detail. This presentation became very interesting among the students.

A number of questions have been asked by the audience, both directly related to the issues presented in the presentation and of a general nature. It should be noted the special interest about the tangible and intangible culture of Georgia, Georgian alphabet, the centers of Georgian culture abroad, Georgia's international transit function, Georgia's tourism potential as well as the issues related to the climate change.
