

List of Documents Required for Admission to the Doctoral Program

1. Application addressed to the university rector indicating the faculty and doctoral program (application form in Appendix 1);
2. Copy of ID card or passport;
3. Photograph, size 3x4 cm;
4. Copy of the document confirming the academic degree of a master or equivalent (diploma) or a certificate issued by the relevant higher education institution in accordance with the law on the awarded qualification;
5. Copy of military service certificate or military card (for those with military obligations);
6. Curriculum Vitae (CV) detailing educational and work activities;
7. Certificate/document confirming foreign language proficiency at least at B2 level (as specified by the doctoral program admission requirements);
8. Research project outlining the research topic, goals, and methodology;
9. Recognition document issued by the National Center for Educational Quality Enhancement for those who received higher education abroad;
10. Additional documentation as required, including a certificate from the National Center for Educational Quality Enhancement confirming eligibility to continue studies at the third level of higher education (doctoral program);
11. Copies of materials related to scientific publications, conference participation, and other academic/research activities (certificates, awards, patents, etc.) mentioned in the educational and work activities data;
12. Notarized power of attorney and ID copy if documents are submitted by an authorized person.

Additional Information:

- The minimum competency threshold for the foreign language exam is 51 points.
- Within 5 working days from the publication of the final results, the applicant must sign academic (study) and administrative (financial) agreements with the Georgian Technical University. When signing the agreements, the applicant must present:
 - Two photographs, size 3x4 cm, and an electronic version on a CD,
 - Original diploma and its copy,
 - Diploma recognition document (if necessary) and its copy,
 - Proof of payment of at least half (2000 GEL) of the annual tuition fee (4000 GEL),
 - (Original documents will be returned to the applicant after signing the agreements),
 - The duration of doctoral studies is 3 years.
- Applicants who were informed that they must submit documents from the National Center for Educational Quality Enhancement within two months from the start of studies (confirming eligibility to continue studies at the third level of higher education or recognition of foreign education) who fail to do so within the specified period will have their enrollment

order nullified. Additionally, those who provided a certificate of qualification for a master's degree must submit the master's diploma and its copy.
